

## **Rustic Angel Interiors**

### **Measuring guide for made-to-measure curtains**

#### **General Notes**

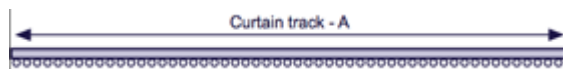
- It is very important that you measure your window carefully to ensure the best possible fit for your curtains. A metal tape measure is probably the best for accuracy.
- First of all you will need to decide whether your curtains will hang from a pole or track, both of which should be positioned approximately 15cm above the window and extend 15cm either side.
- Whether you are using a pole or track it must be fitted before you take your measurements.
- Have a pen and paper handy and maybe an extra pair of eyes and hands to double check your measurements and assist in holding the tape measure!
- Take your measurements in centimetres.
- We will make any allowances required depending on the type of curtain heading you have chosen.
- Do you need lining or blackout lining?
- Once you have your measurements, complete and submit the online Curtain Quotation Form at [www.rusticangels.co.uk/curtain-quotation-form.html](http://www.rusticangels.co.uk/curtain-quotation-form.html)
- We will send your quotation by email, followed up by a telephone call to confirm all details.
- Your curtains will be delivered to your door by courier.

#### **Measure the length of the pole**

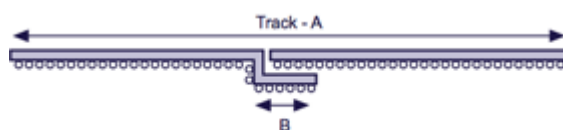
You will need to measure the total length of the pole between the finials. We will make any allowances required depending on the type of curtain heading you have chosen. Ideally the pole should be hung 15cm above the window recess and extend 15cm either side of the window. This will allow a good clearance of the window when the curtains are open. Your pole needs to be fitted before you take your measurements.

#### **Measure the length of the track**

You will need to measure the total length of the track.



If the track has an overlap in the centre measure the full length of the track and then measure the overlap and add it to your measurement.



### **Measuring the drop for the curtains**

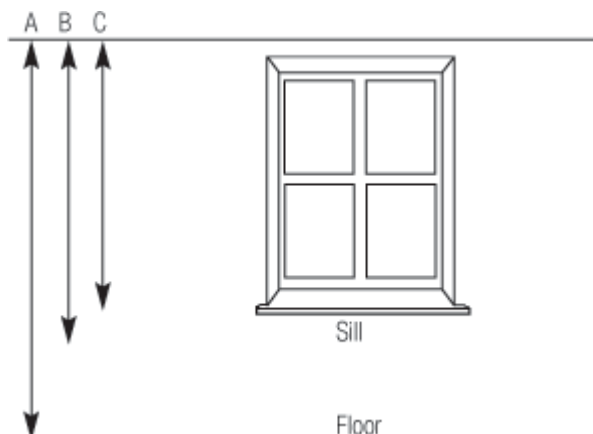
First of all you will need to decide whether you want the curtains to the floor, to the sill or below the sill.

We suggest –

- A. Floor length curtains sit 1cm off the floor.
- B. Below the sill curtains sit 15 – 20cm below the sill or if you have a radiator under the window – 2cm above the radiator.
- C. Sill length curtains sit 1cm off the sill.

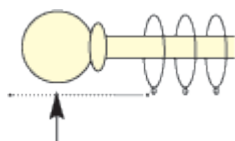
You can, of course, have the curtains “puddle” on the floor – if you would like this option please allow an extra 15cm.

Please note – we will make allowances for hems and turnings.



### **Measuring the curtain drop**

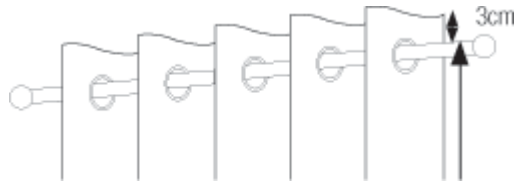
When hanging curtains on a pole, measure from the underside of the decorative ring to where you want the curtains to finish.



When hanging curtains on a track measure from the top of the track to where you want the curtains to finish

### **Measuring for eyelet curtains**

Measure to the very top of the pole to where you want the curtains to finish and then add 3cm. Please note - our eyelets will fit poles up to a diameter of 30cm and the eyelets will be chrome as standard.

**Please note – It is vitally important that you measure your window very carefully to ensure your curtains fit correctly. If you are in doubt, please check your measurements again.
